Description

This position is responsible for the delivery of the grants and agreements program to facilitate and drive waste avoidance and resource recovery initiatives in alignment with the *Waste Avoidance* and *Resource Recovery Strategy 2030*.

The position implements contemporary practice in waste related programs, particularly in the areas of administration of funds for Waste Authority funded programs, to proactively improve community, local government and stakeholder waste practices and performance to deliver excellent environmental outcomes.

The position also works collaboratively both internally and across key stakeholder agencies and industry to provide the Senior Manager Programs with accurate and timely advice and services.

Responsibilities

In context of above description, the role:

- Leads the planning, preparation and delivery of the Grants and Agreements program, including managing governance frameworks and probity processes.
- Implements and maintains the Waste Authority funded programs including Better Bins and Better Bins Plus.
- Delivers program outcomes according to established objectives and timeframes.
- Develops, leads and empowers team members, setting clear expectations and managing performance to deliver quality and timely outcomes.
- Provides subject matter advice to the department on the alignment of grant programs to a strategic framework, with continuous analysis to identify opportunities for consolidation or collaboration.
- Ensures the efficient and effective delivery of the program's objectives including the management of resources to ensure appropriate outcomes are achieved within budget and time parameters.
- Contributes to and participates in, business planning and implementation.
- Builds and maintain positive relationships across the department and the Waste Authority, and across a diverse range of external stakeholders including Commonwealth Government, local governments, community organisations and other State Government agencies, to achieve State Waste Strategy goals and Government priorities.
- Performs additional duties within the skill and scope of position capabilities and departmental needs.
